While we are enabling this feature for all teachers, we understand there are some teachers that will not know how to or be comfortable in creating their Classroom Team and that's ok! Teacher Librarians (will be trained by next week) and Administrators will be able to help support the creation of these Teams, with staff being able to add their students (see page 3 for these instructions). Remote learning does not officially begin until April 14th.

Classroom Teams have unique permissions and features for teachers and students. As owners of the team, teachers assign work, share class content, and control who can post in the team. Each class team is also linked to its own OneNote Class Notebook.
