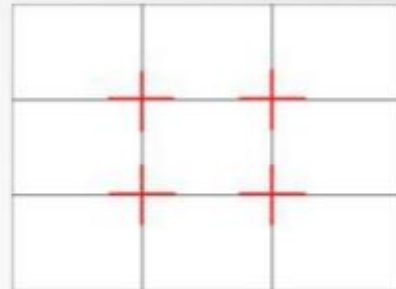


# Brochure Design Tips

## The Rule of Thirds

The rule of thirds works by splitting an image into thirds, so you end up with 9 equal sections, then simply place your main subject where the lines intersect.

The Collaborative Approach is based on four main principles:

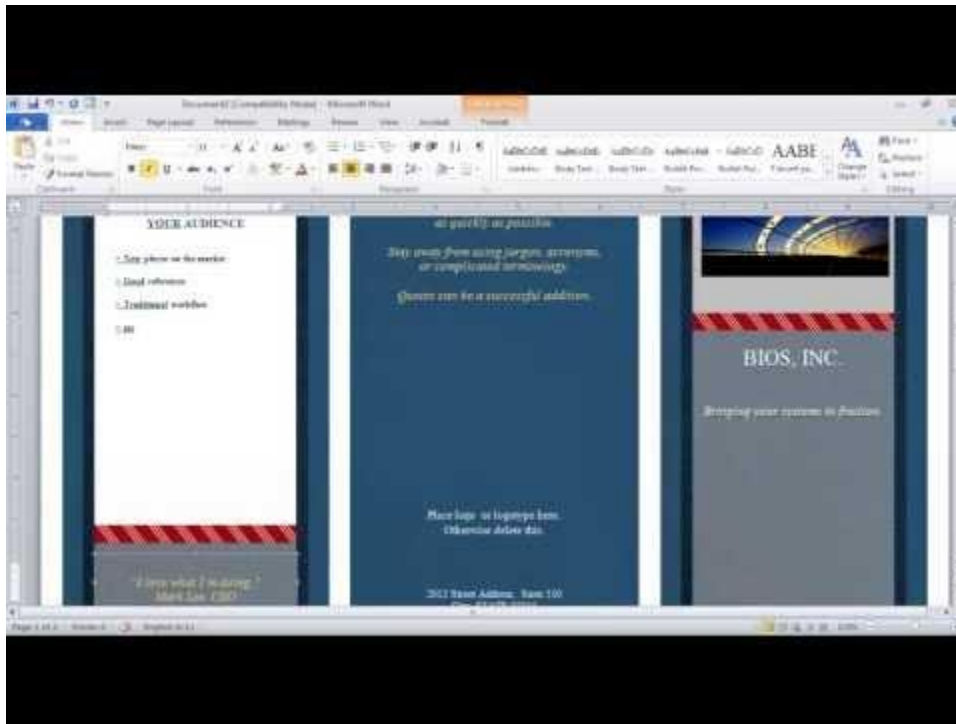
- ✔ A pledge not to go to court
